

Friends of North West Air Ambulance Lottery

Terms and Conditions

The following are the Terms and Conditions of the Friends of North West Air Ambulance Lottery. By entering the Lottery, entrants agree to be bound by these rules.

1. The Friends of North West Air Ambulance Lottery is a weekly subscription draw promoted by and on behalf of North West Air Ambulance. The registered address is North Mersey Business Centre, Woodward Road, Knowsley, L33 7UY.
2. The Friends of North West Air Ambulance Lottery will be operated as Society Lottery under the Gambling Act 2005.
3. This Prize Draw is licensed by the Gambling Commission, our promoter is Fiona Morris, operating licence number 005227-N-304575-008.
4. To enter the Lottery, you must be aged 16 or over and be resident in Great Britain.
5. The directors and employees of North West Air Ambulance are prohibited from entering.
6. All tickets shall be priced at £1.
7. The maximum amount of chances permitted for any individuals is 20 per week.
8. Only members who have paid subscription to the relevant draw will be entered into the draw.
9. Members will not accrue any debt to the Lottery.
10. All advance payments received from the player will be held in account by Friends of North West Air Ambulance and credited upon receipt to the relevant amount of draws in advance.
11. Members should note the dates and frequency of payments and ensure that funds are available to cover the agreed direct debit request. Friends of North West Air Ambulance will not be liable for any charges incurred by the members unless as a result of our negligence.
12. All Lottery entry sales are final and no refunds shall be made at any time. All entrants acknowledge that their payment of £1 per ticket to enter the Lottery does not guarantee that they will win any prize.
13. The draw will take place each week on Friday, in each draw the winning numbers will be selected at random by Gambling Commission recognised Lottery software at the North West Air Ambulance Headquarters.
14. The draw will be operated by a designated officer of the Friends of North West Air Ambulance and witnessed by a third party, who shall record the winning members in writing.
15. Winners will be announced on the day of the draw on the North West Air Ambulance charity website www.nwaa.net. A full list of winners is also available in writing upon request from our Head Office.
16. If a cash prize is awarded, this will be made by cheque in the name of the entrant only, and posted as soon as reasonably possible following completion of the draw to a maximum of 15 working days.
17. In the event that Friends of North West Air Ambulance Lottery ceases to operate any outstanding entry payments will be fully refunded.
18. All entrants are solely responsible for the providing Friends of North West Air Ambulance Lottery with their accurate and up-to-date contact details. Friends of North West Air Ambulance Lottery will be in no way liable for any failure or inability to contact any entrant due to errors, omissions or inaccuracies in the contact details that the entrant has provided. In the event that an entrant changes their contact details, they will be solely responsible for advising Friends of North West Air Ambulance .
19. Lottery membership can be cancelled at any time by notifying Friends of North West Air Ambulance Lottery in writing, by phone or via email.

20. Friends of North West Air Ambulance Lottery shall not be liable to the member for any loss or damage suffered from or arising from:-
- Any delays or failures in the postal service or the delivery methods used by Friends of North West Air Ambulance or the member from time to time
 - Any delays or failures in any software or other systems used by Friends of North West Air Ambulance for the administration of the Lottery
 - Any delays or failures in the banking system used by Friends of North West Air Ambulance or the member
 - Any refusal by Friends of North West Air Ambulance to accept registration of an individual as a member or the cancellation of a member
 - Any failure to enter a chance into the draw
 - Any event beyond the reasonable control of Friends of North West Air Ambulance
21. Nothing within these terms and condition shall create or should be construed as creating any form of contract between any entrant and Friends of North West Air Ambulance.
22. Any complaints relating to the Lottery should be sent in writing to Friends of North West Air Ambulance giving full details of the complaint and supporting documentation.
23. Friends of North West Air Ambulance is committed to protecting the member privacy. Data that is collected from the member is used lawfully in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998 and is used solely for the purpose of processing Lottery chances, subsequent entry into the Lottery draw, and informing winners that they have won a prize.
24. Any member has the right to access the information held about them. To obtain this information, please contact Friends of North West Air Ambulance in writing.
25. Friends of North West Air Ambulance will not sell, rent or grant access of any personal data to any third party without express prior permission.
26. In the event of any dispute regarding the rules, the decision of Friends of North West Air Ambulance shall be final and no correspondence or discussion shall be entered into.
27. Friends of North West Air Ambulance reserves the right to amend these rules at any time. If Friends of North West Air Ambulance does this, it will publish amended rules.
28. Friends of North West Air Ambulance reserves the right to disqualify any entrant if it has reasonable grounds to believe the entrant has breached these rules.
29. Friends of North West Air Ambulance will not be liable to you in contract, tort, negligence or otherwise for any indirect or consequential loss suffered by you in relation to your participation in the Lottery (including loss of the opportunity to enter the Lottery and/or chance of winning a prize).
30. Each entrant should retain a copy of these Terms and Conditions for their reference.
