Why do we need you?

Volunteers are at the heart of our charity - without volunteer support we simply wouldn't exist.

The North West Air Ambulance Charity's helicopters and rapid response vehicles operate 365 days a year, with highly skilled specialist doctors and paramedics on board. They provide pre-hospital care and hospital transfers to patients across the entire North West region. Since we launched in 1999, the charity has been called to over 22,000 missions.

The North West Air Ambulance would not be here without the support of its community volunteers, supporters and partners. The charity is completely reliant on donations and we need over £9.5 million to keep the North West Air Ambulance Charity service operational.

We welcome volunteers from all backgrounds and we strive to make adjustments to support volunteers of all abilities.

What activities can I get involved with?

North West Air Ambulance Charity are often invited to attend community events, fairs, county shows, festivals and clubs, as well as local village festivals at venues across the region.

Our volunteers engage with the general public to raise awareness of the charity and raise much needed funds through collection buckets and the selling of merchandise.

Events come in all different shapes and sizes, our volunteers might be cheering on supporters taking part in the Manchester 10k run, handing out medals for a Santa dash, selling our merchandise at an event or even taking part in a local bag pack. There are so many opportunities to get involved.

What will I be doing?

Here's some examples of what you can expect -

- Act as an ambassador for the charity and talk to people about the work we do
- Meet and greet participants and spectators at events
- Help set up and clear down the event
- Support participants as they take part in challenge events, by marshalling, cheering or handing out medals
- Help with administration
- Sell merchandise or collect donations
- Dependent upon experience you could even get involved with training or driving an information trailer

There's lots of variety in our events roles, you will be given the opportunity to take on a role that suits you.
